

Instalation:

- install the included fonts. (copy files to *C:Windows\Fonts*)
- copy contents of archive into your foobar installation directory as they are, choosing
- "overwrite" when/if prompted.
- start foobar and go to "*Preferences->Tools->WSH Panel Mod*" and untick "*Safe Mode*"
- go to "*Preferences -> Display -> Default User Interface*", click "*Import Theme*" and point to the .fth file you saved in your themes folder.

Tips:

*You will need to provide your Last.Fm username and API key (you will need an user), which you can get from www.last.fm/api/account
- DefaultUI (DUI) skins take menus, borders and scroll bars directly from your Windows' visual style. If you are using a dark DUI skin, consider switching to a similarly dark Windows theme or msstyle. Otherwise, most dark areas in your skin will be surrounded by light gray/white borders and ruin the design.
